

Earlham Cemetery Fungi Listing

Compiled by Ian Senior, April 2014.

Earlham Cemetery has an interesting fungal flora, from parasols to bracket fungi and waxcaps to earthstars. The listing below is a guide to what can be found during the year. Most species are found in the late summer and autumn months but fungi can be seen in any season.

The following listing originates as personal observations coupled with official fungal records for the cemetery. The latter are denoted by + next to the species name. A number of recent records originated from two autumn 2013 fungi walks. One with Jon Tyler and James Emerson, October 2013 (denoted by ~ next to the species name) and a later walk (November 19th) with the Norfolk Fungus Study Group (denoted by #). The vast majority of records originate from the main cemetery block east of Farrow Road (A140).
